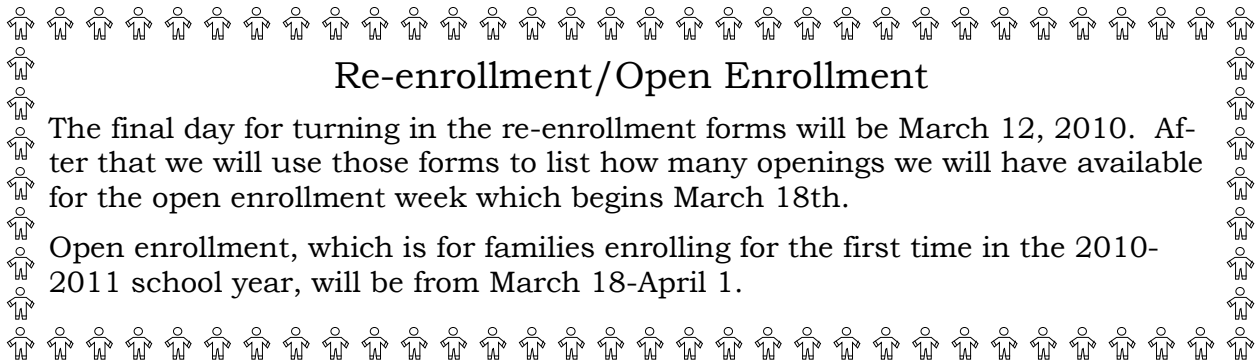
Campus Safety

STUDENT COUNCIL

The student council is sponsoring a “**SPIRIT WEEK**” for all Madison students. We will be celebrating the Madison spirit from March 1st through March 5th.

The schedule is as follows:

Monday, March 1st - Madison Spirit Day (students may wear Madison colors - navy blue, maroon, and white - or any Madison shirt. Tops must have sleeves that are at least t-shirt length and have a crew neckline. The shirt MAY NOT have inappropriate writing or inappropriate pictures. Skirts/dresses must go past the knee, or jeans may be worn with the shirt. Remember to accessorize - add bows, boas, beads, etc...)

Tuesday, March 2nd - Ugly Shirt Day (students may wear a top that has sleeves that are at least t-shirt length, and a crew cut neckline. The shirt MAY NOT have inappropriate writing or inappropriate pictures. Jeans may be worn with the t-shirt. The jeans may not have holes and they may not have decorations on them.)

Wednesday, March 3rd - Mismatched/Backwards Day (shirt sleeves must be at least t-shirt length and have a crew neckline. The shirt MAY NOT have inappropriate writing or inappropriate pictures. Skirts/dresses must go past the knee, or jeans may be worn with the shirt. The jeans may not have holes and they may not have decorations.)

Thursday, March 4th - Sports Jersey Day (students may wear a Madison Academy sports shirt, a college sports shirt, or a professional sports shirt. Tops must have sleeves that are at least t-shirt length and have a crew neckline. The shirt MAY NOT have inappropriate writing or inappropriate pictures. Skirts/dresses must go past the knee, or jeans may be worn with the shirt. The jeans may not have holes and they may not have decorations.)

Friday, March 5th - Crazy Hat or Hair Day (students may wear their hair any way they want, or they may wear a “crazy” hat. Permanent hair colors are not allowed, but temporary colors that can be washed out over the weekend may be used. Any Madison Academy shirt can be worn. Skirts/dresses must go past the knee, or jeans may be worn. The jeans may not have holes and they may not have decorations.)

*appropriate dress code footwear is required for the entire week.

ANY STUDENT WHO RECEIVES A DISCIPLINE REFERRAL THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 22-26, OR THE WEEK OF MARCH 1-5 WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN SPIRIT WEEK.
